

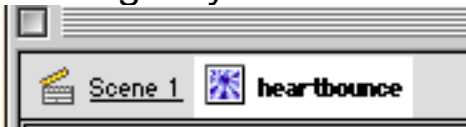
Flash Hearts-1


We are going to make a few 'characters' for a valentine movie, you can use the ideas for other characters to make your movie.

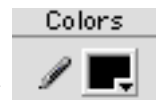
Open Flash.

Choose New Symbol from the Insert Menu
Set the Behaviour of the Symbol to **Movie Clip** and call it Heartbounce


Flash give you a blank stage for your movie clip.



Using the pencil  draw a red heart, set the pen colour to something that is **not** red.

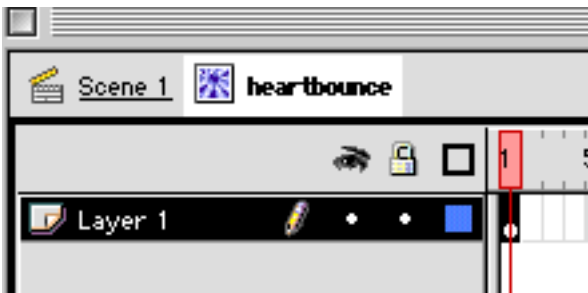


Fill the heart with red  with the paint pot 

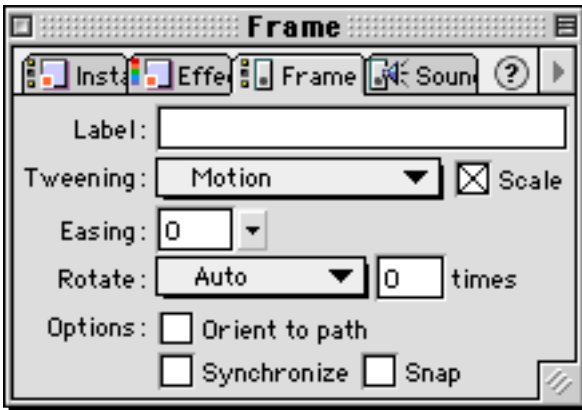
Choose the Arrow Tool  and click on the double click the line round your heart, delete it, leaving just the fill.

Click on the heart shape and choose Group from the Modify menu the graphic now has a blue box round it.

Click on Frame one of the time line of your heartbounce clip

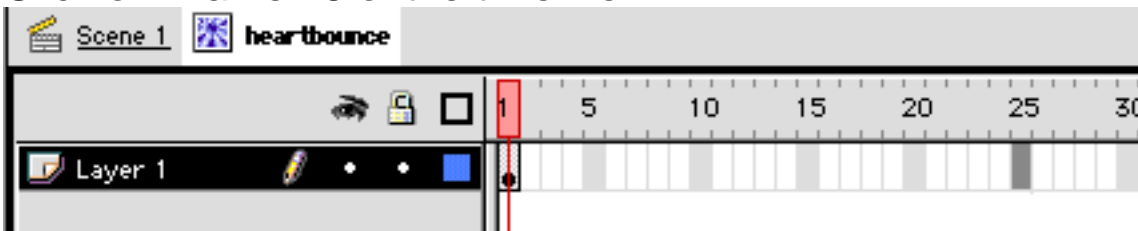


and choose motion from the Frame Panel

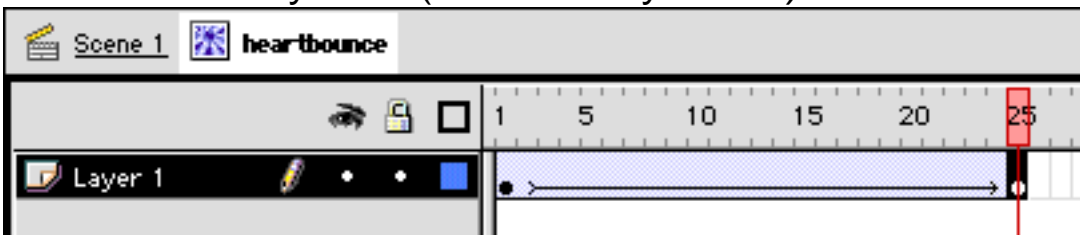


(Window_> Panel ->Frame)

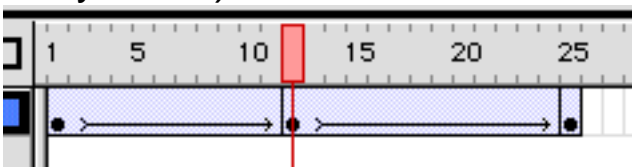
Click on Frame 25 of the timeline:



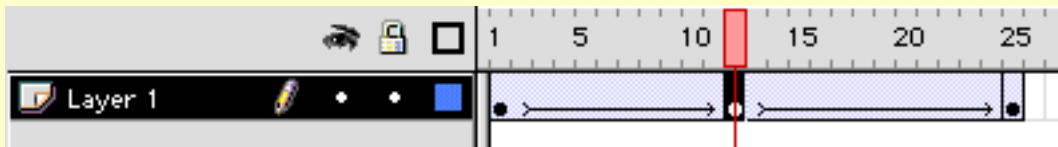
And insert a keyframe(Insert ->KeyFrame)



Click on Frame 12 of the timeline and insert a keyframe(Insert ->KeyFrame)



Select Frame 12



Using the mouse move the heart graphic up a bit on the screen.

Click on frame 1 and then the return key to see your clip.

Inserting you Movie clip (see Flash Hears-3 for more details)

Click on Scene 1 at the topleft of the window.



You will get the blank stage. Drag the heartbounce movie clip from the library to the stage.

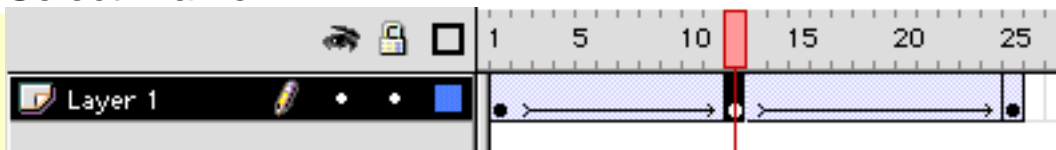
You can duplicate the clip (command D) and make it/them smaller from the transform panel.

Test your movie Control menu -> Test Movie.

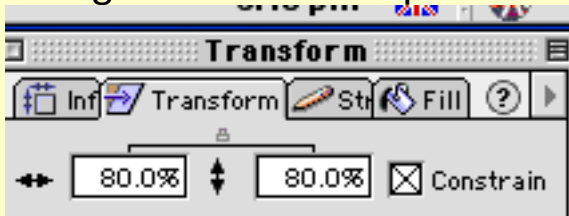
Close the test movie when you have seen enough.

You can make more hearts doing different things, repeat the above instructions, calling the Movie Clip different names, except for the yellow box at the bottom of page 2 try these instead:

Select Frame 12



Using the Transform panel change the size of the clip.



or

Using the Transform panel change the rotation of the clip.
