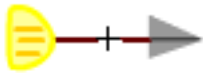



# Flash Hearts-4

This time we are going to fly an arrow across the stage.

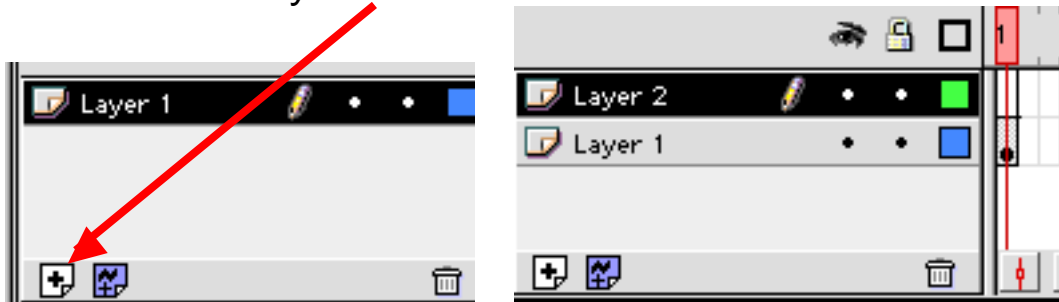
Choose New Symbol from the Insert Menu  
Set the Behaviour of the Symbol to **Graphic** and call it arrow

Flash give you a blank stage for your graphic.  
Use the drawing tools to draw an arrow



Click on  at the top left of the main window.

click the add layer button



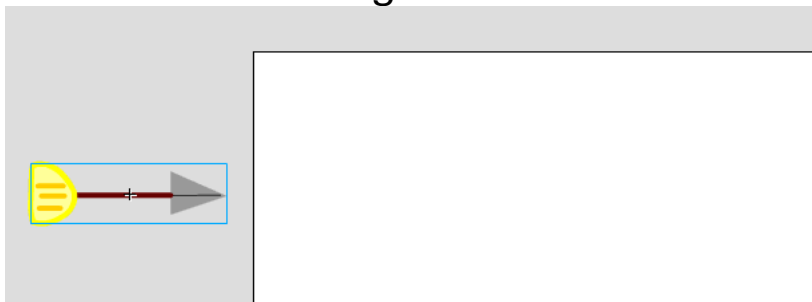
Double click on the words layer 2(or whatever the newlayer is called)



Change its name to arrowpath.

Making sure that the arrowpath layer is selected, drag your arrow graphic from the library to the stage. You may want to scale it with the transform panel.

Darg the arrow off the stage to the left.

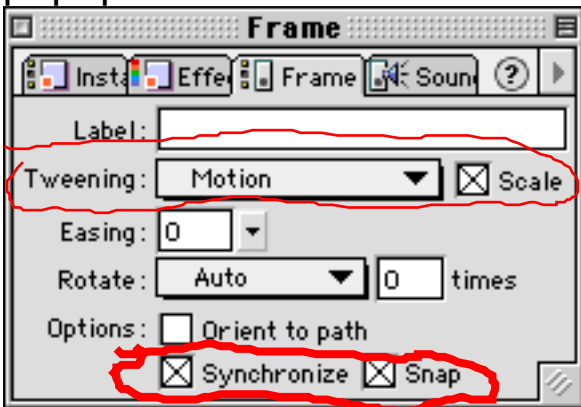


Click on the arrowpath layer



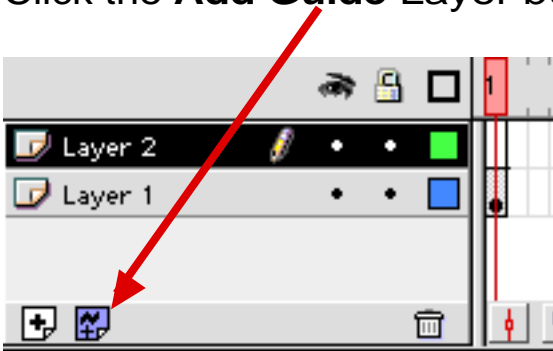
and chose motion from the Tweening

popup in the **Frame** Panel:



Check the Synchronise and snap checkboxes too.

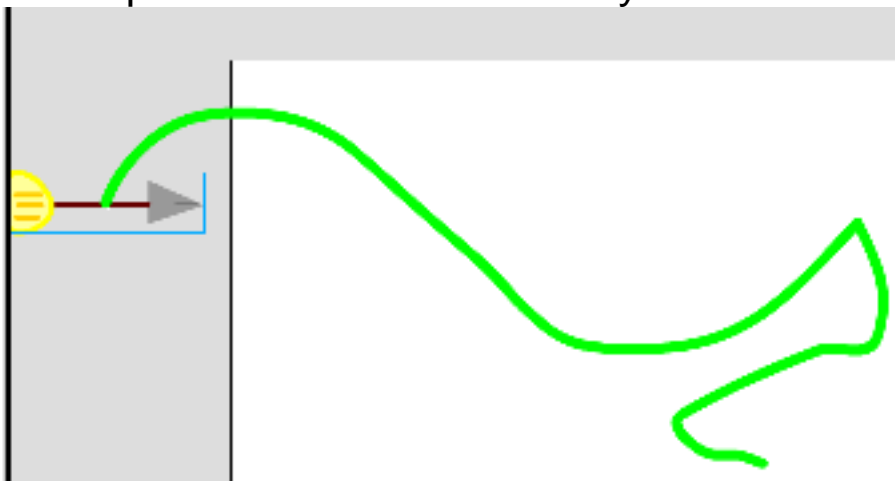
Click the **Add Guide** Layer button:



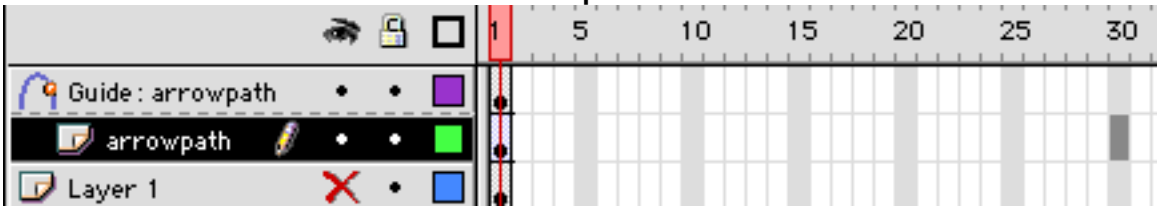
Notice that I have hidden layer one so that the clips, to make it easier to see what is going on.

Click on the Guide Layer to make sure you are working on that layer.

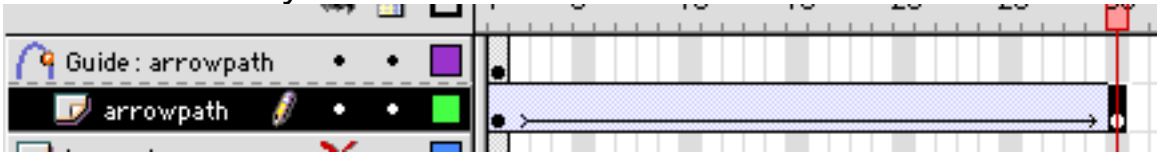
With the pencil tool draw a line for your arrow to fly along.



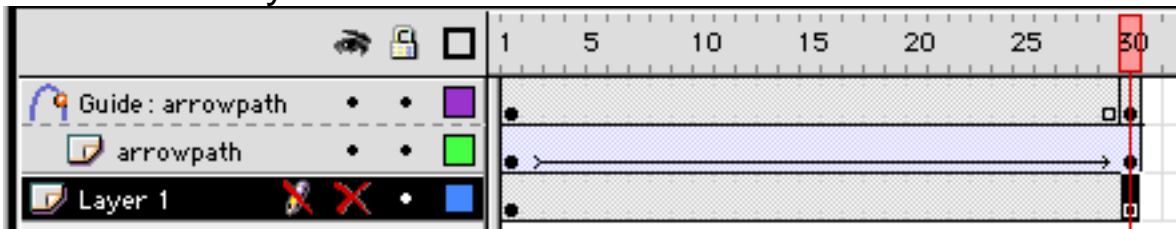
Clikc on Frame 30 of the arrowpath timeline



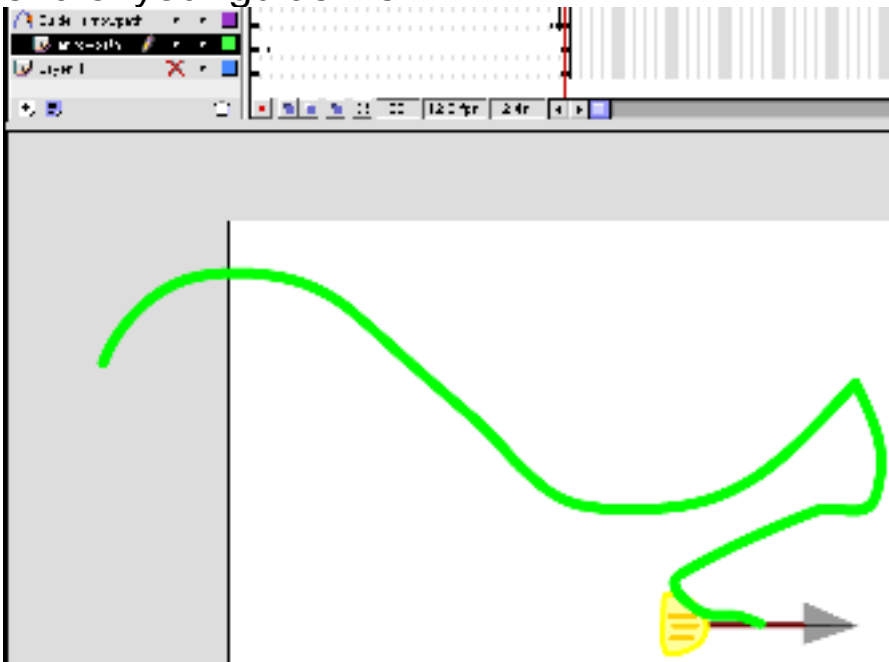
and insert a keyframe



Insert a keyFrame on frame 30 of the Guide Layer and a frame on frame 30 of layer 1



click on Frame 30 of the arrowpath layer and move the arrow to the end of your guideline.




press the return key to play the movie, the arrow should 'fly' along the guide, if it dosen't you need to make sure the arrow is sitting at the start of the guide line on frame 1 and on the end of the guide line on frame 30.

It might be nice to have something from the arrow to stick into.



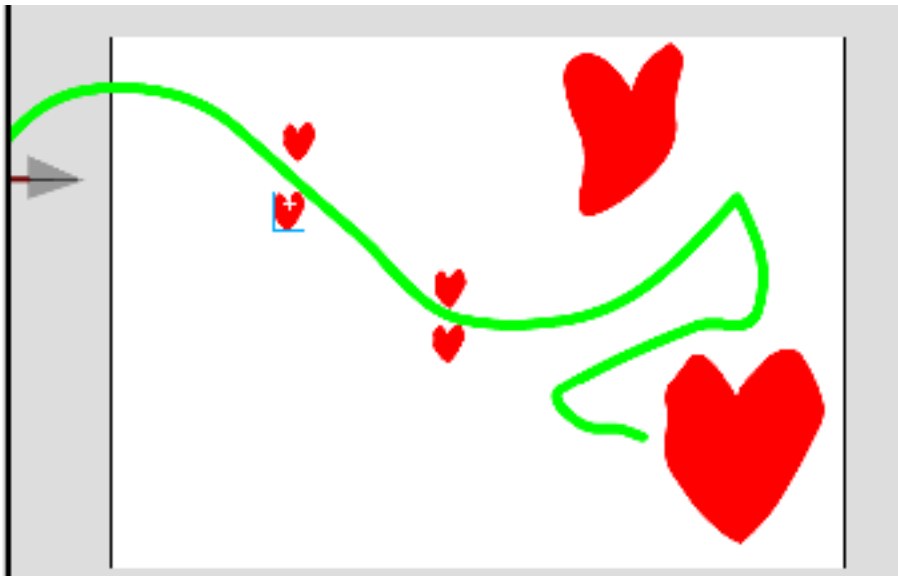
Click on the guide layer and then the

Insert layer button  to add another layer, double click the layer name and call it arrowtarget



Click on Frame 30 of the target layer.

Drag a heart Movie Clip on to the Stage, so that it covers the arrow tip on frame 30, you might want to have a few hearts for the arrow to dodge round, use your imagination.



Test your movie.

You will notice the movie starts again when it gets to the end, we will get it to stop on the last frame when it is finished.
