
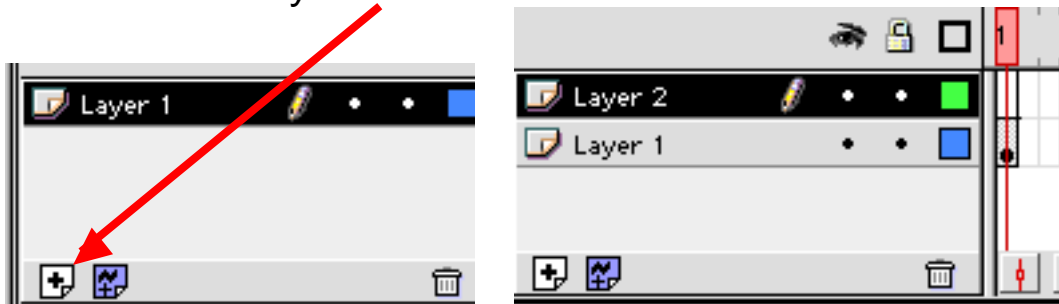


Flash Hearts-5

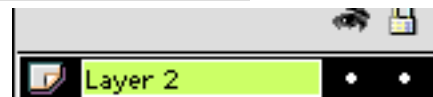
This time we are going to add some text to the movie.

Click on  at the top left of the main window.

click the add layer button



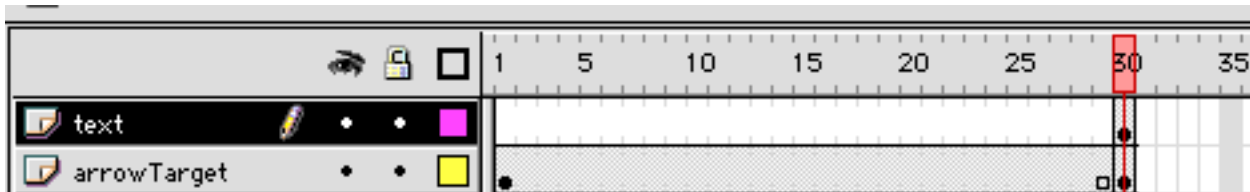
Double click on the words of the new layer




Change its name to text.

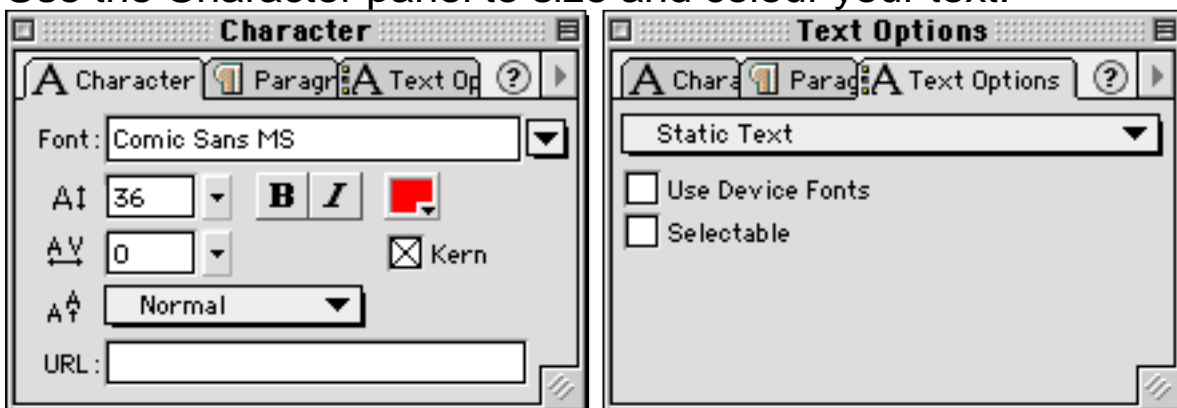


Insert a Keyframe on Frame 30 of your text layer.



Choose the Text tool  and make a text box with your message.

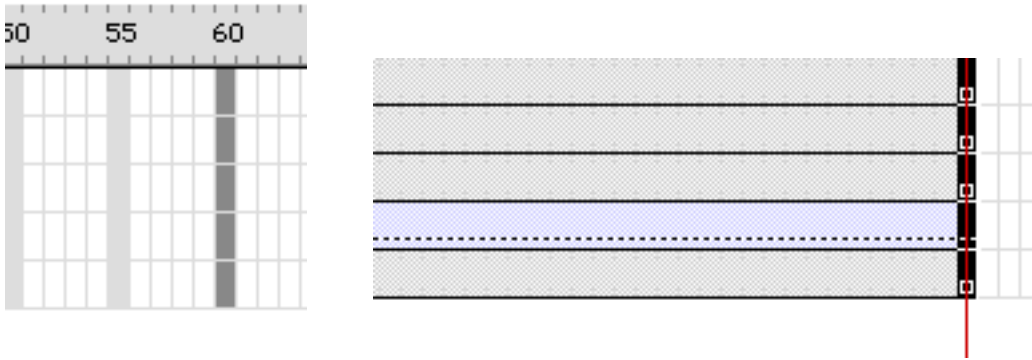
Use the Character panel to size and colour your text:



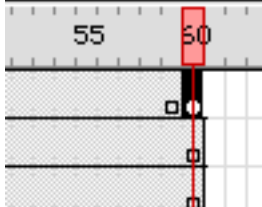
Make sure the **Text Options** panel is set to **Static Text**.

Drag your text box off the stage.

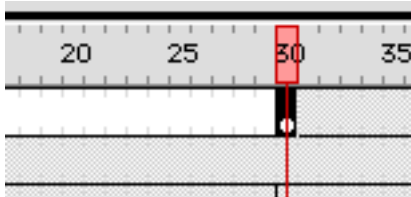
Click on all the layers on frame 60 with the shift key down and Insert a frame



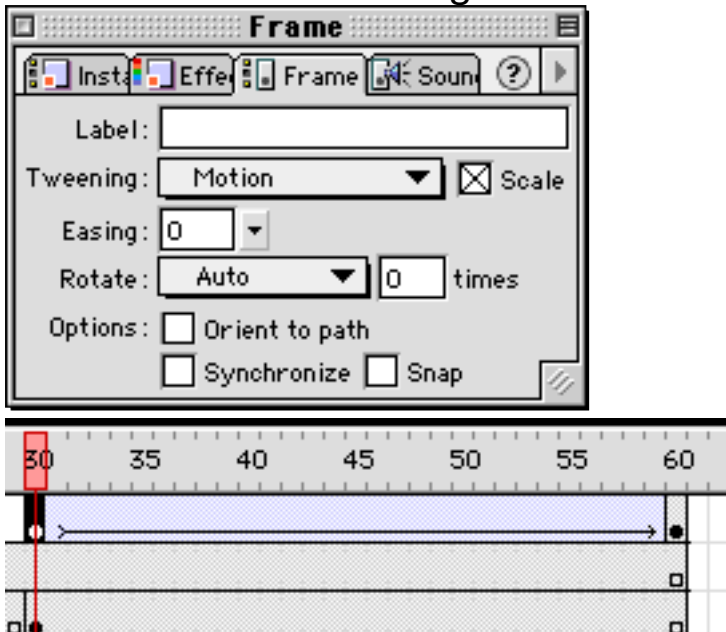
Click on frame 60 of your **text** layer and insert a keyframe



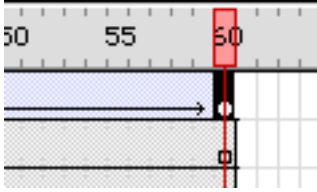
Back on Frame 30 of the text layer



Choose motion tweening from the Frame panel

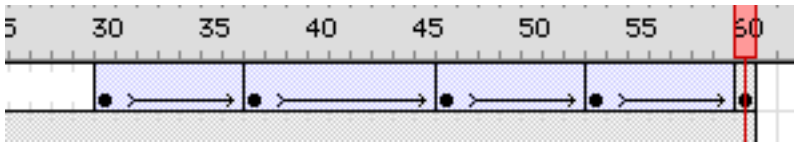


Select Frame 60 of your text layer again

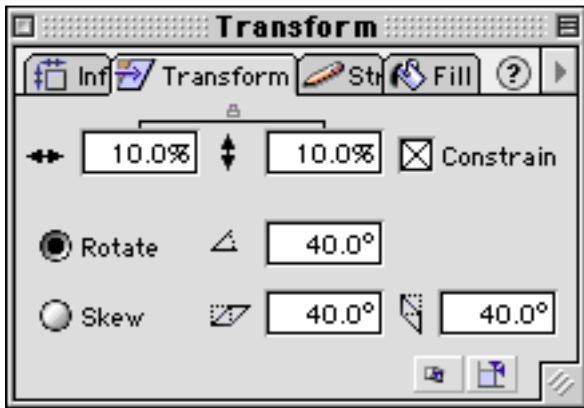


drag the text box to another position on the stage. Press the return key to see the text move from it's starting position.

You can insert more keyframes on the text layer, and move your text box on each keyframe so that it doesn't move in a straight line.



You can also use the Transform Panel



To scale and rotate the clip on your keyframes so that your text flies onto the stage zig zagging and zooming.

As usual Save and test you movie, remember to close the window the movie is testing in to come back to the editing stage.
